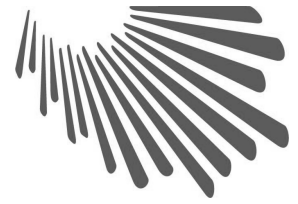


# DaySpring Arts & Education

The MD supports the individual actors as they create their characters, assisting them with pitch, rhythm etc to help them achieve their best version of the character, regardless of their skill level. The Music Director attends auditions, all rehearsals, tech, and performances.

- Plan and teach music to students.

- Attend auditions, class, tech week, and performances, assisting the Director as needed.

- Provide accurate rehearsal tracks and vocal melody tracks to individual actors as well as the ensemble for practice outside of rehearsals.
